The HydroHoist is a hydro-pneumatic device that is located in the berth and provides the means to lift and secure the vessel in place to preserve the hull and metal components that typically come under attack when left in the water. These lifts are produced both in the United States and Germany and were the first boat lift devices patented in 1964. The key to HydroHoist success has been to minimise moving parts. It is the picture of simplicity.
