

# Pumps, props or paddles

**Q**uick, convenient storage of PWCs has become even simpler with the easily-installed HydroPort platform.

HydroPort platforms enable users to quickly dispatch their PWCs and small tenders into the water. Storing them out of the water also keeps the craft free of the marine growth.

Until now, the alternative has been a PWC trailer, and that often means youngsters are unable to launch and retrieve on their own. HydroPort expands playtime, keeps the PWC in top-notch condition and ready to go at a moment's notice.

The HydroPort also helps to preserve the condition of a PWC. Propulsion components and hull materials both tend to show age before their time when hulls are left in the tide. While antifouling offers a means to slow the process, this seldom enhances the vessel's aesthetic appeal.

Furthermore, the heavy metals in the paint that eventually peel off the hull do little for those of us who enjoy shellfish.

HydroPort platforms reduce

maintenance expenses and preserve a PWC's original looks by keeping it dry during storage. Hull speed is optimised because the surfaces are kept smooth, reducing the energy required to push the PWC through the water.

## Versatility

HydroPorts can also be used for other types of watercraft. One new HydroPort user is particularly enamoured with the unit because the propulsion required to power his vessel comes from his own muscles.

Mark Withers has a rowing skiff that is simply elegant. Three different sorts of timber are used and give the interior a rich appearance. The pure white hull is quickly affected by Lake Tarawera's water, affecting looks and speed.

At the end of last summer, Mark's arms were bigger but his times were slower. So he had a HydroPort2 installed for storing his skiff – presto! No more growth. Mark can now concentrate on realising the hull's (and his rowing) potential, knowing that the hull condition remains constant. ■
